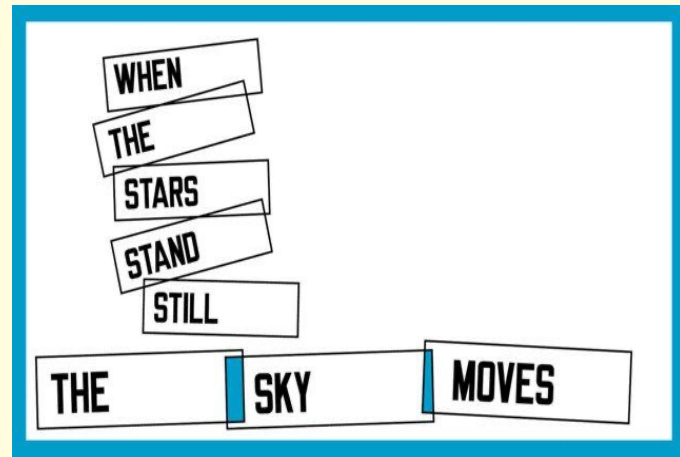

① Ways of words

Activity: Cut and assemble found words to build an idea, a poem or a short story

Time: 30 minutes (ish)

You will need:

A newspaper/magazine, paper, scissors, glue/tape and a hat!

Suggested steps:

1. **Take** a page of text from a newspaper or magazine
2. **Cut** lots of words out so they are in separate pieces.
3. **Select** the words for your poem/story. Choose them at random by placing them in a hat or be playful about your choices.
4. **Arrange** the words creatively on a piece of paper and stick it down.
5. **Give** it a title and take a photo if you can!

What is the Cut up technique?

The Cut up technique involves taking a piece of text, cutting it up and rearranging it to create a new piece of writing. It has been used by artists, poets and musicians throughout history!
