Playful Passport

Activity: Design a paper passport with stamps & stickers for dream travels.

Time: 30 mins (ish)

You will need: A few sheets of paper, pens/pencil, newspaper/magazine, glue or tape



- 1) **Fold** your sheets of paper in half and assemble to make a booklet.
- 2) **Design** your cover, include where you live and a drawing or collage to represent what it means to you.
- 3) **Create** a passport picture of you. You may want to take a photo or draw one. Stick it on one of your pages. Write details to identify you such as date of birth or where you were born or be totally imaginative and inventive!
- 4) **Make** some stickers of places you have been to or would like to travel to. Inspired by Lisa's session this week, you could also draw favourite things about holidays - whether its the food, the sea or music. Stick them all over the pages, make it your own!
